Venue

FDNZ's first residential camp - the hub of the action will be at The Narrows Park just 10 minutes from Hamilton and 2 mins from Hamilton airport.

The camp has a variety of separate facilities suitable for parallel sessions. The Hall has a lovely wooden floor and large open fire place.

Self-contained kitchens are attached to the two accommodation centres as well as a large commercial-style kitchen.

Very reasonable warm accommodation (\$10 per night) will be in shared backpacker-style bunk rooms (maximum 8 people). Powered camping sites are also available. For campervans/caravans etc

There is plenty of space, making bringing the family an excellent option as Narrows Park is conveniently located for many of the Waikato's favourite activities.
