June *Farandol Folkdancer's* tutor Katy Sinton receives Christchurch City Council Community Service Award for 22 years involvement in folkdance.

Jan 45th Auckland Folk Festival at Kumeu now offers punters a huge range of folk music styles as well as an increasing variety of world dances - a workshop & display of French Regional Dances by *La Bourree; The Joy International Dancers* Asian Workshop and a display bracket of six Taiwanese dances arranged by Julia Wei; FDNZ President Fiona led the Euro-Gypsy workshop & hosted the Saturday Night

Dance with *Tamlin* band at which <u>folk</u>dances (not the usual Ceilidh ones) were called by Fiona, Jane & Bronwen; *Rose & Thistle* band featured in three workshops with Karen Vernon on Early Renaissance social dances, Scottish Country with Katharine Hoskyn and Playford Dances with Beth Harris; Ana Maria de Vos Sanchez delivered a Latin American dance workshop; Have-a-Go sessions included maypole dancing;

- Feb Dance Folkus Colonial Dancers entertained at the Hamilton Gardens Arts Festival.
- Apr *Mountain Rhythms* live-in weekend event held at Pukeatua, Waikato. Workshops by 10 NZ tutors covered a variety of dance styles. Socials included dancing to live music by folk musicians hailing from Northland to Gisborne.
- June 20th Anniversary Ball for Auckland's English Country Dance Group
- June Mountain Rhythms feedback survey results indicate participants very positive response
- June Costume bank survey results confirmed insufficient use was being made of it to warrant future retention by FDNZ. Costumes to be donated or sold.
- July Auckland's biennial *Viva Eclectika: An Explosion of Cultural Fusion* included FDNZ President Fiona Murdoch as one of three judges. Organised by the New Zealand-Asia Association Inc. in which member Ana Maria de Vos Sanchez has a supporting role.
- Aug World Dance Repertoire Workshop at Auckland (selected from Andre van der Plas's annual resource kit) taught by Rae Storey & Bronwen Arlington
- Sep Jane Austen High Tea held at Dunedin with dancing led by Kate Grace (annual event).
- Oct *Dance Folkus*, with financial support from FDNZ, ran *Dance Souvenirs* workshop at Hamilton where returning dance nomads Jane Luiten and Bronwen Arlington shared their dance souvenirs and stories from Armenia, Georgia, Turkey and Greece. Lively dance music from the *Matangi Minstrels* ensured a fun evening social to follow.
- Sep FDNZ auditor Sue Watt passed away. *Wellington World Dance Group* performed the Armenian dance Daronee at her funeral.
- Dec Three FDNZ members started new local community classes Jane Luiten in Gisborne (monthly 'Good Folk Dances from Planet Earth'); Rosa Trancosa in Nelson; and Barbara in Wellington.

- Nov A fundraiser for Hibiscus Coast Hospice includes *Athena* Dance Group performance at Orewa for a Greek Extravaganza
